### Booking Your Flight

This trip is LAND ONLY to allow you the option of airlines and best fares as well as the opportunity for pre/post trips on an independent basis. Domestic and International air transportation are not included. Participants are responsible for arranging and paying for their transportation to and from the following destinations:

Registration is important as it will keep you updated on local travel security and allows the State Department to assist U.S. citizens during an emergency. ### **Health and Vaccination Information**

To ensure proper health preparations prior to your tour, meet with your health care provider. Information and medical/inoculation recommendations for travelers can be found at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website - [www.cdc.gov/travel](http://www.cdc.gov/travel). Be aware that some countries require documented proof of a current yellow fever vaccination upon entering the country.

### **Required Travel Documents**

If your passport will expire within 6 months from the date of entry, you will need to renew your passport prior to leaving the country. If you have less than two blank pages left in your passport, you will need to apply for more pages. Country specific requirements are listed below.

#### **Ukraine**

- A U.S. Passport is required to enter Ukraine.
- U.S. citizens need a visa to enter Ukraine ONLY if they plan to stay more than 90 days, or if your visit is for anything than tourism, private travel or business.
