Dear Study Tour Applicant,

Thank you for applying to join a Heifer Study Tour! Please complete this application packet and return it with the deposit to the Study Tours Office. Your application will be reviewed and you will be notified once you are accepted.

Upon acceptance, you need to begin planning your trip. Heifer Study Tours are land only tours, which means transportation fees to the first destination and transportation home from the last destination are not included. Many tours begin and end in the same city, but some tours will begin in one city/country and end in another city/country. You can find helpful transportation planning tips at www.heifer.org/studytours/traveltips.

While initial travel costs are not covered, Study Tour fees include all items listed in the tour's itinerary such as shared accommodations, meals, tour leaders and guides, workshops, project and cultural site visits, transportation between activities and emergency evacuation insurance. If you have a strong need for a single occupancy room, contact the Study Tours Office. Single occupancy rooms are limited and additional fees will apply. If you have a preferred roommate, please indicate on your application with whom you would like to share a room.

We recognize that travel is not without risk, and we take the safety of our participants very seriously. If deemed advisable, we reserve the right to cancel or interrupt a trip at any time. *Trip itineraries are subject to change*, even after a trip commences. To join a Study Tour, you must complete a waiver form prior to departure.

PARTICIPANT CANCELLATION: Total trip price will be refunded for any cancellation before 60 days of departure.

HEIFER CHANGES/CANCELLATION: All trips are subject to change of itinerary and/or cancellation.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: Once airline tickets are purchased and issued they are typically non-refundable and airline rules apply even in the event of a Heifer change or cancellation. While we make every attempt to follow the announced travel schedule, itineraries may change or be cancelled due to low enrollment, travel advisories or any other situation that may compromise the safety of participants.
